

NAILSEA TOWN COUNCIL - COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING 15 JUNE 2016

Minutes of the meeting of the Community Engagement Committee held on Wednesday 15 June 2016 at 7.30pm at The Tithe Barn, Church Lane, Nailsea.

<u>PRESENT:</u> Cllr Packham in the Chair until the election of Chairman, Cllr Barclay, Cllr Bird, Cllr Frappell, Cllr Heappey (from 8.02pm), Cllr Hunt, Cllr Jameel, Cllr Wilson, the Clerk and the Senior Administrator.

CE34/16 APOLOGIES were received and accepted from Cllr Hamblin, Cllr Petford and Cllr J Tonkin

CE35/16 ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

Cllr Jameel was nominated as Chairman by Cllr Wilson and seconded by Cllr Frappell. As there were no other nominations it was

RESOLVED: that Cllr Jameel be appointed Chairman of the Community Engagement Committee for the ensuing year.

Cllr Jameel took over the Chair.

CE36/16 <u>DECLARATION OF INTERESTS</u>

None.

CE37/16 MINUTES of the Committee held on 27 April 2016 were signed as a correct record.

CE38/16 CONSIDERATION OF THE DELEGATED POWERS OF THE COMMITTEE AND TO

CONSIDER THE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT POLICY
It was proposed by Clir Hunt and seconded by Clir Frappell

RESOLVED:

to RECOMMEND to Town Council to approve the Delegated Powers of the Community Engagement Committee as "to fulfil the Community Engagement Policy" and to approve the Policy.

The vote was unanimous.

CE39/16 APPOINTMENT TO SUB-COMMITTEES/WORKING PARTIES

The following councillors were appointed to serve on the Accessibility Working Party: Cllrs Hamblin, Hunt, Jameel, Packham and Wilson.

CE40/16 FINANCIAL MATTERS

a) Statement of Income and Expenditure to 8 June 2016.

Noted.

CE41/16 TO CONSIDER AN UPDATE ON THE PROPOSED PURCHASE OF NAILSEA YOUTH HOUSE

Cllr Packham reported that the property had been valued at £325,000 and that a structural survey had been completed. The survey showed nothing unexpected for the age of the building that could not be addressed. He has met with Cllr Pasley of North Somerset Council and requested that the building be transferred to Nailsea Town Council at zero cost as it is already a Community Building. Cllr Pasley will have to refer the decision back to the Executive Committee. Cllr Packham said he would contact Cllr Pasley again in a few days if he has not had a response by then.

The Clerk suggested that negotiations could start around the cost of repairs for the building as the survey had highlighted works that would need to be carried out.

Cllr Jameel said she felt the Town Council should push for transfer of the building at zero cost.

Cllr Frappell asked how Portishead and Clevedon got their Community Buildings.

Cllr Wilson said he thought they were given the buildings.

Cllr Packham said he felt Cllr Pasley was surprised to hear that the building was being used by the community at present and that there were people ready to make further use of it.

Cllr Jameel asked if Cllr Pasley had visited Youth House to see its potential.

Cllr Packham said that he didn't believe so but he could suggest this to him next week when he followed up their previous meeting.

CE42/16 TO CONSIDER AN UPDATE FROM THE WORKING PARTY ON IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN COUNCIL'S WEBSITE

Cllr Bird reported that the working party had not met as much as they had hoped but that they had looked at some website structures. He proposed that a change in approach could be taken and rather than just a Nailsea Town Council website, a Nailsea website could be developed with information about the town, managed by, and incorporating information about the Town Council.

Cllr Hunt felt that other aspects of Nailsea town life were already covered by various local websites and Facebook pages.

Cllr Bird explained that a new website could have links to these other sites making all the information available in one place. He suggested that external groups or individuals could be given permission to edit and update specified areas of content. Cllr Bird said that to be higher on a Google search list a website needs content, which the Town Council's current site is lacking. He made reference to Cirencester Town Council's website as a good example of one that is visually pleasing and inviting.

Cllr Hunt said she felt the Town Council warranted its own dedicated website.

Cllr Frappell asked if people actually look at the Town Council's website.

Cllr Hunt said that whilst she couldn't say who the users of the Town Council site are, or that the website couldn't be more user friendly, people need to know the work of the Council, its plans for the future and agendas for meetings.

Cllr Bird said that if the Council involved other local groups, people would stop visiting the other websites and use the Council's instead. He explained that to take this idea forward the new structure would need to be planned and it should be decided what to include. At that point the Council could contact someone to start designing the new website. WordPress templates are available at low cost and can be expanded easily with plugins.

The Clerk said that although there are low cost ways of creating a website those with higher functionality still tend to be expensive. He advised that the Town Council would need to spend considerable time to create and manage a website using a template and to ensure it looked professional and of high quality in terms of branding and consistency would require highly controlled management.

It was agreed that Cllrs Bird and Petford would look at this further, contact Cirencester Town Council to ask about their website and report back at the next Committee meeting.

CE43/16 TO CONSIDER HOW TO IMPLEMENT THE TOWN COUNCIL'S DECISION TO HAVE "A TOWN-WIDE CONSULTATION ON THE SUBJECT OF HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND A FIVE-YEAR STRATEGY"

The Clerk reported that the working party would be having a second meeting with a company on Monday 20 June. Having held discussions with others, it was felt this company had understood the needs of the Council and came back with a realistic proposal in terms of costs. This is on the agenda for the Town Council on 22 June.

CE44/16 CONSIDERATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE QUALITY AWARD SCHEME a) Consideration of the format of Councillor profiles to be published on the website.

The Clerk explained this item had been carried forward from the previous meeting.

Cllr Wilson said he was prepared to try and take photographs of councillors if it was wanted.

It was agreed that photographs were wanted but Cllr Packham asked what additional information should be included.

Cllr Jameel said that at the previous meeting a profile template was suggested to ensure the profile for each councillor was the same but that the questions would need to be decided.

Cllr Barclay suggested including areas of special interest for each councillor so that residents would know who best to contact about specific issues, for example in his case

trees or Public Rights of Way.

The Clerk suggested that the profiles could be written in an interview style to make it more engaging. There could be several standard questions which everyone would answer and then a small number of others from which councillors could choose which to answer depending on their relevance to them individually.

Cllr Heappey arrived at 8.02pm.

Cllr Jameel said she would draft some questions and circulate to members.

CE45/16 CONSIDERATION OF THE NORTH SOMERSET CCTV LOG BOOK FOR APRIL 2016 The Clerk said that Storenet still appeared to be producing good results.

The information was noted.

CE46/16 PUBLICATIONS

a) Nailsea School Newsletter, May 2016

Cllr Hunt took this publication and agreed to pass it to Cllr Packham.

CE47/16 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

a) Cllr Packham said that in advance of the Town Council meeting of 27 July, Barratts are going to hold a workshop with councillors on 13 July to present their proposals. He asked the Committee its thoughts on inviting Nailsea Action Group (NAG) to the meeting.

Cllr Heappey said she thought they should come.

Cllr Jameel said everyone should be able to come including those for and against the sale of land for housing on Engine Lane.

Cllr Hunt suggested asking NAG if a couple of members wanted to come to participate in the meeting. The workshop would not be the place to discuss the rights and wrongs of developing the land at Engine Lane but their opinion on the design, if the scheme should go ahead, would be valued.

Cllr Packham explained that the meeting was an advisory workshop for Barratts to present their designs and information and answer questions.

Cllr Jameel said that in terms of engaging with the community and to maintain openness, inviting members of NAG would be a positive thing to do.

Cllr Packham agreed and said NAG's committee members should be invited to the workshop.

The Clerk said he would contact Matthew Thomas of NAG with the details.

b) Cllr Jameel said that she would not be able to attend the Community Engagement Committee meeting on 3 August and as she was now Chair asked if the date could be moved to ensure she could attend.

The Clerk said he would look to see if this could be accommodated.

The meeting closed at 8.17pm.

5. Consideration of the Delegated Powers of the committee, which are currently "to fulfil the Community Engagement Policy" and to consider the Community Engagement Policy

Community Engagement Policy

It was agreed to define 'Community' as 'all the residents of Nailsea'. Those groups with members of the community were also highlighted as needing to be part of the Engagement Strategy.

The aims of the Community Engagement Strategy were defined as the Town Council:

- Engaging positively with the community and communicating what it does.
- Aiming to get more members of the community engaged as volunteers, assisting in specific projects (such as Christmas lights and Nailsea in Bloom) and community organisations (including standing for election to Town Council).
- Identifying target groups, understanding their needs and developing methods of communication appropriate to each group e.g. social media, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, web-site, local media, printed newsletter, internet newsletter, questionnaires and surveys (printed and electronic), face to face with individuals and groups.
- Identifying accurate demographic data regarding the community.
- Facilitating the activities of community organisations through practical assistance, coordination and, if necessary, financial support.
- Supporting projects and campaigns, where practicable.
- Developing a greater community pride in Nailsea as a place to live and work.
- Creating a physical space based on the Nailsea Place concept of a Community Hub. This
 could be a shop or a larger building.
- The purpose of the Hub was defined as:
 - To create a community facility with multiple uses e.g. cafe, meeting/activity spaces, internet access (eg. young people teaching older residents' digital skills), youth facility, information on community activities and local organisations.
 - To create an identity (brand) that would make the Hub a place attractive to all the community. The Tithe Barn is a model for this, as is Barcode for young people. This may include a logo. It was agreed that a 'council' brand would not be appropriate.
 - o To create opportunities for organisations to combine resources and strengthen networks.
 - o To promote the activities of organisations within the town.
 - o To create opportunities for volunteering, both within the Hub and elsewhere.

10. To consider how to implement the Town Council's decision to have "a town-wide consultation on the subject of housing development and a five-year strategy."

At the last meeting it was agreed to look for a professional company that could assist with a public consultation. This will be reported on in full at the Town Council meeting on 22 June, with a proposal for the costs of a town-wide consultation.
